

# Case Study - Citibank



*At this building in the coastal city of La Jolla just north of San Diego, exhaust from a single micro turbine heats water both for heating and cooling offices.*

*The cooling side of the equation is accomplished by routine heated water to a pair of hot – water driven absorption chillers that produce nearly 20 tons of air conditioning. Right around the corner, four-story Collins Asset Management Group office building uses exhaust from two micro turbines to direct-fire a 40-ton absorption chiller.*

*Both facilities count on the automatic dual-mode capability of their micro turbines to serve critical loads in the event of blackout.*
